### Crime Watch

A new phone scam: Identity thieves trick the unwary into revealing personal information (social security number, birth date, credit card numbers, etc.) by telling them that he/she, the caller, is from their local court and that you, the victim, has failed to report for jury duty and a warrant for their arrest is being issued. The victim is caught off guard and not wanting to be arrested gives out information when asked for "verification" purposes.

This summer we had an incident where mail (bills being paid) was taken from a mailbox. The homeowner put the mail in the box before going to work in the morning. Several weeks later, he was notified by the postal inspectors that a man had been picked up and his checks were in the man's possession.
