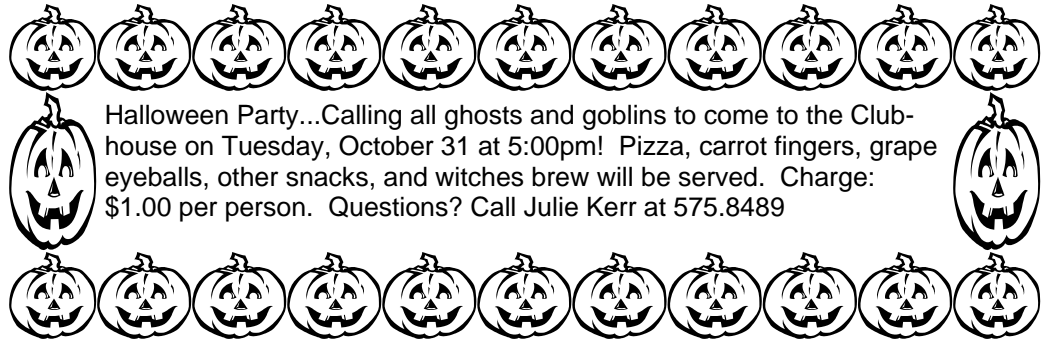

Halloween Safety Tips:

- Turn on exterior lights to welcome trick-or-treaters to your home
- Make sure costumes are flame-retardant and sized to fit the child
- Put reflective tape on costumes
- Report any suspicious or criminal activity to Carmel Police
- Use make-up instead of masks. Masks can obstruct children's vision
- An adult should accompany younger children
- Drive slowly all evening
- Go out in daylight and carry a flashlight in case of delay
- Stay within the neighborhood and only visit homes you know
- Keep costumed children away from pets. The pets may not recognize the child and become frightened
- Only give and accept wrapped candy and examine all candy before allowing the children to eat it
